The daughter of Italian immigrants, Gina was born in Brooklyn, N.Y. and at age 12, was plucked from the familiarity of American life and carted off to Sardinia, Italy, after her papà died tragically. In a reverse immigration story, Gina shares stories of growing up in the 1930-40s both in Brooklyn and a poor Sardinian village under the watch of a strict mamma raising three children alone. Gina's daughter, Suzanna, shares anecdotes of growing up as the granddaughter of that same woman, *Nonna Antonica*.
