

We are sold out! The Little Italy Lodge OSIA Foundation provides college scholarships to "Famiglia" of our Lodge members and each of you is testimony to our collective persistence and faith in our educational mission. Thank you for joining us this afternoon.

I have been President since 2018 when the Foundation separated from the Lodge as a non-profit. The Foundation consists of 16 Board Members chaired by Vince Piscopo. Most of our board are also Lodge Members who devote time, talent and treasure to the cause. The Foundation also includes 10 At-Large Committee members who manage operations.

Our Foundation relies on revenue from the Annual Taste of Italy and during 2020, COVID compelled us to cancel and yet our generous donors gave \$12,000 to transition us till today. Taste of Italy is budgeted to net over \$16,000. Our dear friend and benefactor, Carl Julio, has donated \$30,000 these past two years to expand our number and value of scholarships. Since Academic Year 2019, the Scholarship Foundation has sponsored 3 years of scholarships to qualified candidates and been able to increase the total value and number of scholarships each year. The Scholarship Program began in 1999 under the vision of Mr. Guy Matricciani and continued under the aegis of Jerry and Angela Elliott. We stand on the shoulders of Baltimore's Italian-American giants and as a result, we have distributed over a quarter of a million dollars to 73 deserving awardees. We also appreciate the Little Italy Lodge President, Dr. Albert Marra, who also sits on our Board. Special thanks to Maureen Chandler and her Taste of Italy Team and to Christopher Pisano for producing our Taste of Italy program book.
