Today's Honoree Dr. Andrew Ross



Taste of Italy Committee honors Dr. Ross for spreading the cultural, innovative, artistic and entrepreneurial spirit of the Italian people, through his volunteer and career efforts to improve the lives of children and youth.

"I have always been proud of being Italian, yet never so humbled and surprised, that the leaders of the Scholarship Foundation, who do so much to perpetuate our culture, would honor me. Grazie mille!"

Andy's grandparents emigrated from the provinces of Salerno (San Rufo & Sant Roseario) and Naples (Sasso & Risigliano), Italy; he was named after his paternal grandfather, Andrea Rosa. When his employer spelled it as Ross, Andrea's eventual 10 children and 30 grandchildren were denied a vowel at the end of their surname.

Andy honors his Italian heritage through his membership in the Little Italy Lodge, promotion of its scholarship program and judging students' essays, and as a volunteer for St. Leo's Italian Festival. He is active in the Associated Italian American Charities of Maryland (AIAC) and is pursuing dual Italian citizenship for him and his family: daughters Kate LeBar and Emily Brown; and grandchildren, Spencer, Amelie, Rosa, and Augie.

As the recruiter and coordinator of the exotic Italian car show fundraiser, *Concorso Italia*, Andy brought the show to Baltimore, once staging it on the streets of Little Italy. It became wildly popular and moved to Harbor East and Rash Field during the Italian Festivals once held there.

At *The Children's Guild Alliance*, a nonprofit organization in Baltimore, where Andy was President & CEO during a 26-year tenure, he used his artistic and entrepreneurial skills to grow its mission from 154 children to 6,000. Before stepping down in 2021, he founded six public charter schools and two special education schools; and installed in-house mental health centers in 90 public schools throughout the Baltimore-DC corridor.

Andy also created a management approach that improved outcomes for educating and managing child-serving organizations, and brought modern apprenticeships (unrelated to trades) to Maryland from England. He has authored two books and published 18 journal articles on ways to care for - and educate - traumatized children.

Andy transformed the floors, ceilings, and cinder block walls of schools into three-dimensional art by hiring artists to visualize the values and learning systems he created. This, and the 30 musical theater productions he wrote and produced (three performed at Baltimore's Hippodrome Theatre), were used to promote The Guild's work and grow its budget from five- to \$85 million. This earned the organization a prestigious national reputation, as Andy's ideas spread throughout America and several countries. The Guild was recognized as one of the top five-percent of well-funded children's organizations in the United States. *Bravo to Dr. Ross for these phenomenal accomplishments and for his work with our Foundation!*

HOW STUDENTS CAN APPLY FOR A 2025-2026 SCHOLARSHIP

- Scholarships offered to high school seniors continuing full-time at an accredited two-or four-year college/university and to college students enrolled full-time.
- The **applicant** must be a member of the Little Italy Lodge, spouse of a member; or a child, grandchild, step-child/grandchild or legal ward of a member.
- The **sponsor** must have been a member in good standing of the Lodge as of 1/1/2024.

- Submission deadline **May 31, 2025** for 2025-2026 scholarships based on this question:

Many Italian American families can trace their roots back to a specific region in Italy. Investigate your family's region of origin, noting any special customs, dialects, dishes, or festivals unique to that area. Compare how those traditions are practiced (or remembered) in your household today. Discuss which elements you'd like to preserve, adapt, or leave behind as you grow into adulthood.
